


Zero Maintenance Light Weight Ball Bearing Steering Kits: #1003, 1004, 3013, 1080

MIP's Ball Bearing Steering systems will work on graphite or tub chassis.

COMPLETE ASSEMBLY



Read Instructions Before Installation:

- 1. Remove the stock steering assembly.
- 2. Screw the stock ball ends into the bell cranks or try MIP's oversized B.J. Ball Ends to remove
- 3. Follow the diagram to assemble and install the steering bell cranks onto the chassis.
- 4. Use a Kimbrough servo saver with these steering systems.
- 5. Do not oil or spray out bearings with cleaner.
- Gently use a soft brush to clean away dirt.

 6. For the RC-10T. Cut the #8 short center screw that holds on the nose piece flush with the chassis. This will allow clearance for the steering arm.
